Free Application for Federal Student Aid

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is now available. Students and parents may complete the FAFSA for consideration of Federal and State financial aid. This user-friendly application has been updated to include built-in edits to help prevent costly errors and implements skip logic to prevent the applicant from answering unnecessary questions. Additional changes include: the ability to

link information from your most recent tax return to the FAFSA; the name of the high school from which the applicant graduated; a more simplified login process; and new language regarding applicants who receive food stamp benefits.

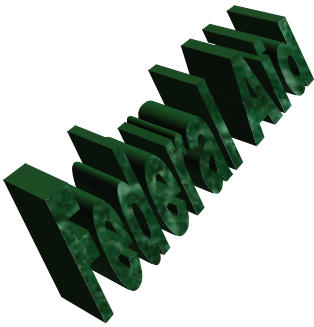
