### **Legislative Session 2014**

The Florida 2014 Legislative Session commenced March 4. The Florida Department of Education, Office of Student Financial Assistance will be monitoring a number of proposed bills that may affect programs currently administered through our department. As information becomes available at the end of session, OSFA will announce any changes pertinent to state scholarships and grants.



# CGS!Florida Update

The Florida Department of Education, Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) is a strong advocate for College Goal events in our state. This year, OSFA served as state coordinator in partnership with the Florida Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators (FASFAA) serving as the fiscal agent.

Florida was fortunate to have 44 host sites covering the state in January and February. Preliminary data shows that CGS!Florida was able to serve 1,143 students and families with Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) assistance. Records received to date also indicate that 866 FAF-SAs were completed, with many more in various stages of completion. The 2014 participation nearly tripled last year's attendance, and we are on track to exceed these numbers for next year. Special thanks to the many sponsors who donated goods and services to assist host sites with refreshments, office supplies, door prizes, and more: Publix, Subway, Florida College Access Network, Gilly Vending, school districts, universities, and state colleges.

In addition to receiving assistance with FAFSA completion, 80 students were chosen to win CGS! Florida scholarships worth a total of \$13,000.00! Way to go Florida!
