Free Application for Federal Student Aid

The 2014-15 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is now available. Students assisted by parents may complete the FAFSA for consideration of federal and state financial aid for the 2014-15 academic year. This user-friendly application provides built-in edits which help prevent costly errors. The FAFSA also implements skip logic to prevent the applicant from answering unnecessary questions. In addition, applicants also have the

ability to link information from students' and parents' most recent tax returns to the FAFSA beginning February 1st.

Remember, the FAFSA may be completed using estimated data (with the expectation that it will be updated upon completion of the 2013 income tax form). Visit the FAFSA website for answers to questions you may have or call toll-free at 1-800-4-FED-AID (1-800-433-3243) or 1-319-337-5665.
