IRS Data Retrieval Tool—Latest Update

Last month, a joint announcement was made by Federal Student Aid and the Internal Revenue Service that the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) is offline until the next Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) season which begins October 1, 2017.

More recently, another update stated that there has been a security breach and possibly 100,000 FAFSA filers may have been impacted. The IRS is working to secure the data retrieval tool and notifying students who are directly impacted.

How can potential FAFSA filers move forward in light of this situation?

Students can continue to file the FAFSA and manually input their 2015 tax information. <u>Immediately request a tax</u> <u>transcript and be prepared to provide this to the institution</u> <u>if requested.</u> Transcripts may be obtained through: <u>www.irs.gov/transcript</u> or call 1-800-908-9946 to order a copy to be mailed to you. **Important Announcements**
